Dear Pheasant Hills Park and Summer Fest Parade Route Neighbors:

The parade will step-off at 1PM on Sunday June 10th from High Point Trails Drive and Sheffield Avenue; just north of 81st Avenue. Parade units will start to line up at noon on Austgen Place and on High Point Trail Drive, east of Sheffield Avenue. The parade will continue north on Sheffield/Hart to Greiving Street. Turning east, the parade continues to Nondorf Street and then turns north to disperse. Spectators should sit along Hart St. anywhere between 77th Avenue and Greiving St. This year, Hart St. between Osage Drive north to Cherry Hill Road is a mandated **QUIET ZONE** with no music or sirens allowed.

The parade lineup will cause temporary or limited access in the parade staging area. This area consists of:

- *Bibich School parking lot
- *Austgen Place, Peschel Court, High Point Trails Drive east of Sheffield Ave

Once the parade route is closed, approximately 12:30PM, all streets connecting to Sheffield/Hart from 81st to Stech Street will be closed. This includes the following streets (see map on back):

High Point Trails Dr. east and west of Sheffield, Brighton Lane, Deertrail Lane, 77th Avenue, Chateau Lane, Heather Lane, Scotty Lane, Margraf Court, Osage Drive, Cherry Hill Road, Berens Street, Mary Street, Park Manor Drive, Plum Creek Drive, Greiving Street, Nondorf Street, and Stech Street.

The following streets will have limited access during and immediately following the parade:

Moller Street, Henry Street, Oak Street, and Elm Street.

We anticipate the parade will end at approximately 3:00PM.
